3. 4. The institutions shall adhere to the fulfillment of the provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 and ensure the following before commencement of the session:-

- The institution shall comply with various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- The institution shall comply with the condition as laid down in the clause 8(3) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 which provided that "An institution which has been recognized by the Council shall obtain accreditation from an accrediting agency approved by Council within five year of such recognition."
- The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.
- As per the provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 the following norms have been prescribed for staff/ qualifications/administrative and professional staff/terms and conditions of service etc.

**NORMS AND STANDARDS FOR BACHELOR OF EDUCATION PROGRAMME LEADING TO THE

5.1 Academic Faculty

For an intake of two basic units of 50 students each, that is total students strength of 200, there shall 16 full-time faculty members.

The distribution of faculty across different curricular areas shall be as under:

1. Principal / HôD	One
2. Perspectives in Education	Four
3. Pedagogy subjects (Maths, Science, Social Science, Language)	Eight
4. Health and Physical Education	One
5. Fine Arts	One
6. Performing Arts (Music/Dance/Theatre)	One

- Note: (i) The faculty positions listed under different subject categories may teach course(s) in the Teacher Education Programme across curricular areas specified, and can cater to both foundation and pedagogy course(s). If the students strength for two years is one hundred (with one basic unit) only, the number of faculty shall be reduced to 8.
- (ii) Faculty can be utilized teaching in flexible manner so as to optimize academic expertise available.

5.2 Qualifications

The faculty shall possess the following qualifications:

A. Principal / HOD

- (i) Postgraduate degree in Arts / Sciences / Social Sciences / Humanities/Commerce with minimum 55% marks; and
- (ii) M.Ed. with minimum 55% marks; and
- (iii) Ph.D in Education or in any pedagogic subject offered in the institutions; and
- (iv) Eight years of teaching experience in a secondary Teacher Education Institution.

Desirable: Diploma/Degree in Education Administration or Educational Leadership.

B. Perspectives in Education or Foundation Courses

- (i) Postgraduate degree in Social Sciences with minimum 55% marks; and
M.Ed. degree from a recognized university with minimum 55% marks.

OR

- (i) Postgraduate (MA) degree in Education with minimum 55% marks; and
B.Ed./B.El.Ed. degree with minimum 55% marks.

C. Curriculum and Pedagogic Courses

- (i) Postgraduate degree in Sciences / Mathematics /Social Sciences/Languages with minimum 55% marks; and
M.Ed. degree minimum 55% marks

Desirable: PhD degree in Education with subject specialisations.

[Note: In case of B and C put together, for two faculty positions, a postgraduate degree in Sociology/Psychology/Philosophy with 55% marks, and B.Ed. /B.El.Ed. with 55% marks and three years of teaching experience in a secondary school shall be considered].

D. Specialised Courses Physical Education

- (i) Master of Physical Education (M.P.Ed.) with minimum 55% marks. (Training/qualification in yoga education shall be desirable)

Visual Arts

Post graduate degree in Fine Arts (MFA) with minimum 55% marks

Performing Arts.

- (i) Post graduate degree in Music/Dance/Theatre Arts with minimum 55% marks.

Note : In a composite institution, the Principal and academic, administrative and technical staff can be shared. There shall be one Principal, and others may be termed as HoDs.

5.4 Terms and conditions Service

The terms and conditions of service of teaching and non-teaching staff including selection procedure, pay scales, age of superannuation and other benefits shall be as per the policy of the State Government/Affiliating body.

4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfilment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, the State Government etc. as applicable and compliance of the following by the affiliating body, State Govt and also the concerned recognised Institution:-

- (i) The affiliating bodies/State Govt. shall be required to verify the authenticity of the land & building documents with the required land & built up area as well as appointment of requisite teaching & non-teaching staff as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 by the concerned institution before grant of affiliation to an institution.
- (ii) The affiliating body shall ensure that the institution is composite institution as per the definition of composite Institution given in the NCTE Regulation, 2014. If at any stage, it is found that the institution is not a composite institution, the recognition, granted will be treated as withdrawn and the sole responsibility of the same will be of the institution. However, in the existing institutions permitted for additional intake, shall have to ensure that they are to become composite gradually preferably the academic session 2016-17.
- (iii) The NOC of the affiliating body and staff approval thereof submitted by the institution, if found fake at any stage, the recognition, granted will be treated as withdrawn and the sole responsibility of the same will be of the institution.

5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

6. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:-

- (i) Copy of the Application Form
- (ii) Land and Building Particulars
- (iii) Staff Profile
- (iv) Recognition letter
- (v) Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

7. In case if the land is in the name of the Society/trust, the land is to be transferred within six months in the name of the institution, failing which action shall be initiated to withdraw the recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate about the same to the respective Regional Committee along with the new land documents within the stipulated time.

8. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

9. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the order, it may prefer an appeal under sections 18 of NCTE Act, 1993 in the "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte.org within 60 days from the date of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.

WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-section (2) of Section 32 of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993 (73 of 1993) and in supersession of the National Council for Teacher Education (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2009, the National Council for Teacher Education has notified the Regulations, 2014 on 01.12.2014.

2. AND, WHEREAS, the recognition has been granted to the institutions mentioned in para 5 below for the course mentioned against their name.

3. AND, WHEREAS, the said institutions by affidavit have consented to come under New Regulations and have sought for the number of units in **B.Ed./B.P.Ed./M.Ed.** as mentioned in para 5 below against their name, which may require additional facilities.

4. AND, WHEREAS, it has been decided to permit the institution to have the desired number of units subject to fulfilling the following conditions:-

- (i) The institution shall create additional facilities that include (a) additional built-up-area, (b) additional infrastructure, (c) additional funds, (d) adhere to staff norms as per Regulations, 2014 and inform Regional Committees with required documents by October 31, 2015.
- (ii) The applicant Institution for additional unit will be required to submit the required documents, such as, land documents, Non Encumbrance Certificate (EC), Change of Land Use Certificate (CLU) and Building Plan (BP) in the specified proforma available on the website of the Regional Committee in proof of having provided the additional facilities before October 31, 2015. Building completion Certificate (BCC) may be given along with other documents if available, otherwise it can be given to the Visiting Team at the time of inspection.
- (iii) The Regional Committee shall arrange for verification of documents, inspection of the premises and check adherence to these conditions by 20 February, 2016. If it is found by the Regional Committee that the institution has failed to comply with these requirements, the institution shall not be permitted to admit students for the academic year 2016-2017.
- (iv) In case any existing institution's matter is sub-judice under court direction/SCN under section 17 of the NCTE Act/ Complaint etc., the institution shall be required to submit a copy of the Hon'ble Court order/reply to SCN/complaint already submitted alongwith documents, if any, together with the documents referred above. In case the institution's request for shifting of premises is pending, such institution shall be required to submit the requisite documents as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 with a copy of the order/NOC of the affiliating body/State Govt. and such other documents as indicated in the revised format recognition order. This order shall be subject to the directions given by the Hon'ble Court in the Writ Petition/case and in respect of Section 17/complaint cases etc. as decided by the Northern Regional Committee.

5. Now, therefore, in light of the above, the Northern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby issues the revised Recognition Order to the following institutions for conducting the under-mentioned programme/intake of two years duration from the academic session 2015-2016 subject to fulfillment of the conditions before 31.10.2015 mentioned in para 4 above:-







RECOGNITION ORDER

Whereas, the Western Regional Committee, (NCTE) had granted permission to the PACIFIC COLLEGE OF TEACHER'S EDUCATION, VILLAGE - DEBARI, STREET ROAD- AIRPORT ROAD, TALUKA- GIRWA, TOWN CITY- DEBARI, UDAIPUR - 313003, RAJASTHAN for conducting B.A.B.ED. / B.SC. B.ED. 4 years Integrated course, with an annual intake of 100 students (two units of 50 students each) from the academic session 2021-2022 vide order of even No. dated 21st January 2021.

2. Aggrieved by the decision of WRC in granting permission for the academic session 2021-2022, the institution approached the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India W.P. (C) No. 40/2021 and the Hon'ble Court had passed an order. The directions of the Hon'ble Court were considered by WRC in its 324th meeting of WRC held on 23rd - 24th and 31st December 2020 and the WRC decided as under:

"Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, has informed us that there is no question of counselling in his client's case, as his client is an unaided Institution, which admits students on its own. Having perused the writ petition(s) and the annexures thereto, it is clear that he is right in stating that the recognition that was granted for the academic year 2021-22 was granted on 23rd-24th and 31st December, 2020 December, 2020 much later than the application that was made, and due to this delay of the authorities, recognition could not be granted for the academic year 2020-21. In any case, we have been informed by the learned counsel that even so far as aided institutions are concerned, counselling continues at least until 18th of January 2021.

"This being the case, we direct the authorities to grant recognition for the academic year 2020-21 within a period of one week from today. The petitioner - institution may then admit 100 students within one week thereafter.

The matter was discussed, and it was revealed that a similar kind of directions were issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court/High Court of MP in WP NO. 5559/2015 & the clarification was sought by WRC from NCTE - Hqrs. The NCTE Hqrs vide letter No. 64-183/2014/NCTE/Legal/3300 dated 03rd September 2015 had directed to RCs to comply with the directions of the Hon'ble Court.
